Cefazolin Sodium (Ancef) - Critical Care

Description

Cefazolin Sodium (Ancef) is a cephalosporin antibiotic used to prevent and treat a wide range of bacterial infection.

Indications

- Severe or deep wounds to include:
 - Crushed/exposed tendons
 - Open Fracture
 - o Deep Puncture
 - o Heavy Contamination
- Administration is reserved for patients with more than 1 hour between injury and arrival at the hospital.

Procedures

- Dose
 - o 1g IV or IM.
 - o Ancef must be reconstituted with 2.5mL normal saline.
 - o For IV administration dilute in 100mL normal saline and administer over 10 minutes.
 - o For IM administration administer in lateral thigh or glute.

Contraindications

- Allergy to cephalosporin antibiotics.
- Prior anaphylactic reaction to penicillin (simple rash/itching is not considered a contraindication)
